
- Code of labour laws

- Local authorities


#### Situation on labour market in Ukraine (Total (000s))






#### Situation on labour market in Ukraine (White collars (000s))





#### Situation on labour market in Ukraine (Blue collars (000s))






## State and Regional programs of employment of population
